Dorothy Ables is chief administrative officer for Spectra Energy Corp, responsible for the company's information technology, audit services, human resources, support services and community relations functions.

Most recently, she served as vice president of audit services for the company, and as chief ethics and compliance officer.

Ables joined the company in 1985 as a senior financial analyst in investor relations for predecessor company PanEnergy Corp. Through a series of promotions, she gained broad leadership experience with the company's natural gas transmission business, primarily in the strategic planning and financial areas. Additionally, she provided oversight of areas such as information technology, human resources, community relations and public affairs.

She was named senior vice president and chief financial officer for Duke Energy Gas Transmission in 2000 and was named vice president of audit services and chief compliance officer for Duke Energy in 2004. She was named to her current position in November 2008.

Before joining the company, Ables worked in the audit department of Peat, Marwick, Mitchell & Co.

Ables received her Bachelor of Business Administration degree in accounting from the University of Texas at Austin.

Ables serves on the boards of the United Way of Greater Houston and the Collaborative for Children. She is a past president of The Junior League of Houston and The Children's Fund.
