Greg Ebel is president and chief executive officer of Spectra Energy Corp and a member of the company's board of directors.

He also serves on the board of directors for DCP Midstream, a joint venture between Spectra Energy and ConocoPhillips and a leader in natural gas gathering and processing and the production and marketing of natural gas liquids.

Prior to his current role, Ebel held the position of Spectra Energy's chief financial officer. He has also served as president of Union Gas, Spectra Energy's major Canadian natural gas utility company, and he has broad experience in both the finance and energy sectors.

He served as Duke Energy's vice president of investor and shareholder relations in Charlotte, N.C., from November 2002 until 2005. He joined Duke Energy as managing director of mergers and acquisitions in March 2002 as a result of the company's acquisition of Westcoast Energy.

At Westcoast, Ebel served as vice president of strategic development where he had responsibility for merger and acquisition activities, financial forecasting and analytics associated with major capital investments across Westcoast Energy companies.

Before joining Westcoast in 1998, Ebel was advisor to the executive director of the World Bank Group in Washington, D.C., where he had oversight responsibility for investment proposals of the International Finance Corporation, the private sector investment arm of World Bank. From 1989 to 1993 he worked for the government of Canada, holding positions as chief of staff to the minister of finance and deputy prime minister of Canada, and as senior advisor on privatization.

Ebel received a Bachelor of Arts degree from York University, Toronto, Ontario, in 1987 and is a graduate of the Advanced Management Program at the Harvard Business School.

A native of Ontario, Ebel was born in 1964. He and his wife Kimberly have two daughters.
