Mark Fiedorek is group vice president of Spectra Energy's U.S. Transmission and Storage – Southeast. He is responsible for the company's Southeast U.S. assets, which include the southern portion of Texas Eastern Transmission, East Tennessee Natural Gas, Market Hub Partners, Gulfstream Natural Gas and Southeast Supply Header.

Fiedorek also serves on the board of directors for Spectra Energy's publicly traded partnership, Spectra Energy Partners.

Fiedorek joined the company in 1988 as a supply planning and evaluation analyst for Texas Eastern Transmission. Through a series of promotions, he gained broad leadership experience with the company's natural gas transmission business, primarily in the supply, planning, operations and marketer services areas, and was named general manager of marketer services in 2000. After the acquisition of Westcoast Energy in 2002, he was named vice president of asset optimization and marketer services, and was named to his current position in 2007.

In 2003, Fiedorek received Duke Energy's most prestigious Pinnacle Award for outstanding contributions to the company's business success.

The Dallas, Texas, native earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in managerial studies from Rice University.

Fiedorek and his wife, Anne Hutton, have a daughter and four sons.
